Supervisor Jon Kavanaugh called the Hearing for Budget and Appropriations of the Cordova Township Board of Trustees to order at 7 p.m. in the Cordova Township Office on June 18, 2012.

Supervisor Kavanaugh stated that no changes had been made on the proposed budget and appropriations for Road and Bridge and did the Board have any questions. There were none. Bonnie Hanna made a motion, seconded by Robert Coers, to approve the 2012-2013 Cordova Road and Bridge Budget and Appropriations Ordinance. Ayes: Boone, Coers, Hanna, McLaughlin and Kavanaugh. Supervisor Kavanaugh asked if there were any questions or discussion on the proposed budget and appropriations for the Township, Cemetery, Civic Center and General Assistance Budget and Appropriations Ordinance. He stated that one change was made. It was an addition of \$500 to the Cemetery fuel line item with a corresponding \$500 deduction taken from the Cemetery Maintenance Road line item. JoAnne Boone made a motion, seconded by Bonnie Hanna, to approve the 2012-2013 Cordova Township, Cemetery, Civic Center and General Assistance Budget and Appropriations Ordinance.
