Supervisor Morris McLaughlin called the Truth in Taxation Public Hearing for Cordova Township Board of Trustees to order at 6:30 pm. in the Cordova Township Office on December 18, 2017.

Citizens Wishing to Address the Board: Bob Reynolds addressed the Board and asked the purpose of the Black Box Levy. Why do we need the money? Why can't we lower taxes? The Board explained the Exelon Tax agreement and the need to create the new agreement as the previous agreement had expired.
